

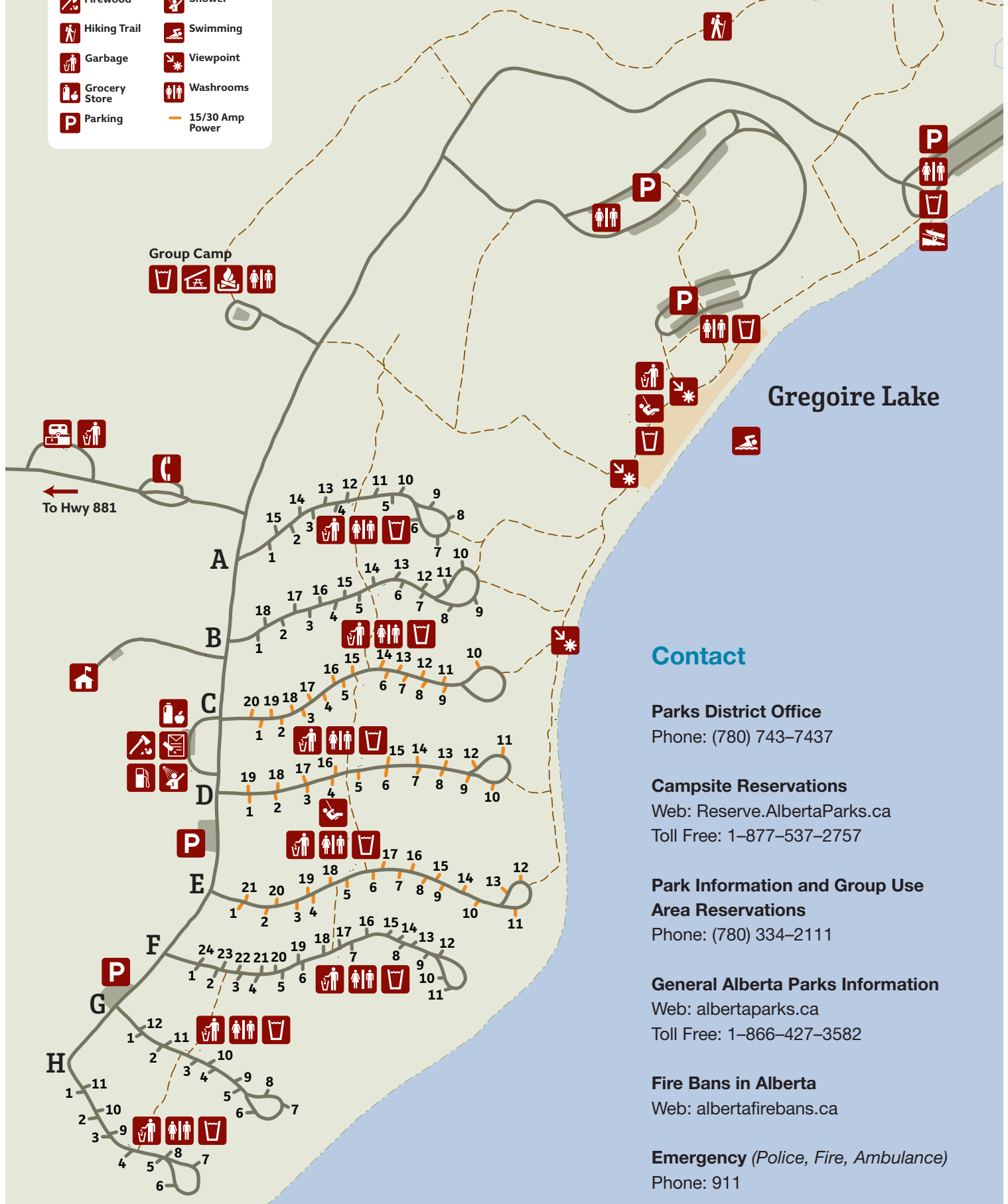
Gregoire Lake Provincial Park

Explore the park and the lake in this aspen and spruce mixed wood forest. The lake is great for boating, canoeing and kayaking, as well as fishing and swimming. There are trails for walking, cycling and cross-country skiing in winter (not groomed). Across the lake, the Anzac day use area has beach and a swimming area.

Facilities in the park include basic and power campsites, shower facilities, a boat launch, fish cleaning stands, potable water, and a sewage dumping area. A group camping area is available, by reservation, for your family gatherings or other group events. This area will accommodate 20 camping units and provides toilets, potable water, firepits and a picnic shelter.
