COOKING LAKE - BLACKFOOT GRAZING, WILDLIFE AND PROVINCIAL RECREATION AREA

FIRSTLY:

All that parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the fifty-second (52) township, in the nineteenth (19) range, west of the fourth (4) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

All that portion of the said township being designated as Cooking Lake Forest Reserve, as shown upon a or plan of survey of the said township approved and confirmed at Ottawa on the 6th day of July, 1915 by E. Deville, Surveyor General of Dominion Lands, and on file in the Department of Recreation and Parks at Edmonton.

SECONDLY:

All that parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the fifty-second (52) township, in the twentieth (20) range, west of the fourth (4) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

All that portion of the said township being designated as the said Cooking Lake Forest Reserve and lying generally to the south of the northerly limit of the surveyed road from Edmonton to Beaverhill Lake, as shown upon a or plan of survey of the said township approved and confirmed at Ottawa on the 6th day of July, 1915 by E. Deville, Surveyor General of Dominion Lands, and on file in the Department of Recreation and Parks at Edmonton.

SAVING AND EXCEPTING:

- 1) The south west quarter of section eighteen (18), as shown upon a or plan of survey of the said township approved and confirmed at Ottawa on the 7th day of December, 1911 by E. Deville, Surveyor General of Dominion Lands, and on file in the Department of Recreation and Parks at Edmonton.
- 2) Seven hundred sixty-five thousandths (0.765) of a hectare (1.89 acres), more or less, out of the north west quarter of section eighteen (18) and one hundred thirty-four thousandths (0.134) of a hectare (0.33 of an acre), more or less, out of the south west quarter of section nineteen (19) required for a road diversion, as shown upon a plan of survey of record in the Land Titles Office at Edmonton for the North Alberta Land Registration District as No. R-6078.
