CARSON-PEGASUS PROVINCIAL PARK

FIRSTLY:

All those parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying, and being in the partially surveyed sixty-first (61) township, in the eleventh (11) range, west of the fifth (5) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

The north half of section eighteen (18), legal subdivision five (5) and the northwest quarter of section twenty (20), the west half of the south west quarter of section twenty-nine (29) and all those portions of sections nineteen (19), the north west quarter of the said section twenty-nine (29), section thirty (30), the south half of section thirty-one (31) and the south west quarter of section thirty-two (32) of the said township, not covered by any of the waters of McLeod Lake, Little McLeod Lake or Laura Lake, containing eight hundred twenty-six and nine hundred sixty thousandths (826.960) hectares (2,043.39 acres), more or less.

SECONDLY:

All those parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying and being in the partially surveyed sixty-first (61) township, in the twelfth (12) range, west of the fifth (5) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

The north east quarter of section thirteen (13) and all those portions of sections twenty-four (24) and twenty-five (25) of the said township, not covered by any of the waters of the said McLeod Lake, containing three hundred eighty-two and six hundred seventy-six thousandths (382.676) hectares (945.58 acres), more or less.

The lands herein described contain one thousand two hundred nine and six hundred thirty-six thousandths (1,209.636) hectares (2,988.97 acres), more or less.
