PETER LOUGHEED PROVINCIAL PARK

All that parcel or tract of land, situate, lying, and being in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the south boundary of unsurveyed section two (2), township nineteen (19), range eight (8), west of the fifth (5) meridian with the Alberta - British Columbia boundary;

Thence generally westerly and northerly along the Alberta - British Columbia boundary to its intersection with the Banff National Park boundary in unsurveyed township twenty (20), range ten (10), west of the fifth (5) meridian;

Thence generally northerly along the easterly boundary of Banff National Park to the summit of Mount Smuts;

Thence northeasterly along the height of land to the summit of an unnamed mountain in the north east quarter of section thirty (30), of unsurveyed township twenty-one (21), range ten (10), west of the fifth (5) meridian;

Thence northeasterly along the southerly watershed boundary of the tributary of an unnamed creek to the fork of the said tributary and said creek;

Thence downstream along the said creek to Smuts Creek in the south east quarter of section thirty-two (32), of the said township;

Thence downstream along Smuts Creek to its intersection with the north boundary of the said township;

Thence easterly along the north boundary of the said township to the north east corner thereof;

Thence southerly along the east boundary of the said township to a point distant two thousand one hundred twelve (2112.00) feet, more or less, from the said north east corner;

Thence easterly up the slope along the height of land to the summit of Fortress Mountain in the north west quarter of section thirty-one (31), township twenty-one (21), range nine (9), west of the fifth (5) meridian;

Thence southeasterly along the height of land of the Kananaskis Range to the summit of Mount Lawson;

Thence southeasterly down the slope along the height of land of the said mountain to the source of an unnamed creek and continuing downstream along the said creek to the Kananaskis River in the south west quarter of section eleven (11), of the said township;

Thence upstream along the Kananaskis River five hundred (500.00) feet, more or less, to an unnamed creek;

Thence upstream in a northeasterly direction to the source of the said creek;

Thence southeasterly up the slope along the height of land to the summit of Mount Evan-Thomas; Thence southeasterly along the height of land of the Opal Range to the summit of Elpoca Mountain, and continuing southeasterly along the said range to the summit of an unnamed mountain in the south east quarter of section thirty-four (34), township nineteen (19), range eight (8), west of the fifth (5) meridian;

Thence southeasterly down the slope of the said unnamed mountain along the height of land to the height of land on the most northeasterly shoreline of Elbow lake in the northwest quarter of section twenty-six (26) of the said township;

Thence southeasterly along the said height of land and continuing southeasterly up the slope along the height of land to the summit of an unnamed mountain in the north east quarter of section twenty-three (23), of the said township;

Thence southeasterly along the height of land of the Misty Range to its intersection with the south boundary of township nineteen (19), range seven (7), west of the fifth (5) meridian;

Thence westerly along the south boundary of the said township and continuing along the south boundary of township nineteen (19), range eight (8), west of the fifth (5) meridian to the point of commencement.

SAVING AND EXCEPTING:

- 1) Twenty-six and eight hundred twenty-eight thousandths (26.828) hectares (66.29) acres, more or less, required for Lower Kananaskis Lake Subdivision and Lake Shore Drive, as shown upon a plan of survey of record in the Land Titles Office at Calgary for the South Alberta Land Registration District as No. 1964 I.X.
- 2) Two hundred seventeen and four hundred eighty-one thousandths (217.481) hectares (537.39) acres, more or less, required for a surveyed roadway, as shown upon plans of survey of record in the said Land Titles Office as Nos. 831 1035, 831 1163 and 831 1421.

The lands herein described contain fifty thousand one hundred forty-two and three hundred thirty thousandths (50,142.330) hectares (123,900) acres, more or less.
