

What to Expect with Comfort Camping Yurts

Get familiar with comfort camping at Pigeon Lake Provincial Park!

Extend Stay at Check-In

Comfort Camping reservation holders must check in at the booth. Check in time is 4:00pm. Party members cannot gain access to the yurts without the reservation holder. Pets are not allowed. ***Do not stop or park in the right-hand lane. It is a through lane, and you could get hit by other vehicles.***

- For the 2021 season, there are restrictions on booking due to COVID-19 restrictions & cleaning protocols.
 You will only see a Friday opening when booking. The stay will include Saturday night.
 You will automatically be charged the two-night fee (double a daily fee).
 If you would like to extend, you can do so after you have checked in.
 You are allowed to extend up to two additional nights.
 You will only be charged the daily rate for each day you extend.

 - After you turn off Highway 771, follow the road about 1km to the entrance. It is on the left-hand side of the road.
 - The entrance to the campground has a large sign that says Pigeon Lake Provincial Park. This is the entrance to the Day Use and campground.
 - The speed limit at the entrance is **15km per hour.** It is important you follow this, as there are trails and foot traffic along the road into the park.



Stay in the left-hand lane to check in at the booth.

Checking In	 Check-in time is 4:00pm. Check-out time is 12:00pm. The reservation holder is the only person who can check-in for the yurts. Keys will not be given to anyone else. Check-ins must be before 9pm. If you will not make it before the booth closes, you must let the campground know. The reservation holder must sign an agreement at check-in. Pigeon Lake has two check-in windows. If you are waiting in line, look to see if a staff member is waving you to walk up to a window. Please turn off your vehicle and walk up to the windows to register.
