



Tipi Comfort Camping includes:

- ◆ Tipi with 4 twin-sized raised platform beds that may be re-arranged
- ◆ Private full-serviced bathroom, with shower
- ◆ Access to a full-serviced enclosed cook-house (similar to the kitchens of our cabins), BBQ, and outdoor fire-pit, picnic table, and wood benches

What to Bring

- ◆ Food & beverages
- ◆ Pillows, sleeping bags or duvets/blankets with sheets
- ◆ Towels, hand towels, toiletries, hair dryer, etc.
- ◆ Flashlight
- ◆ Additional lawn chairs or camping chairs (if desired)
- ◆ Insect repellent and sunscreen
- ◆ Appropriate clothing and footwear, hat and sunglasses

Rules

- ◆ Check-in time is 4 p.m. Check-out time is 12 p.m. (noon).
- ◆ Pets are not allowed in or around comfort camping sites, with the exception of registered service animals. Service animals are allowed if accompanying a person with a disability, and as long as the animal is kept in control. Users of service animals should have government-issued identification cards for confirmation.
- ◆ Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the tipi, cookhouse, and on the deck.

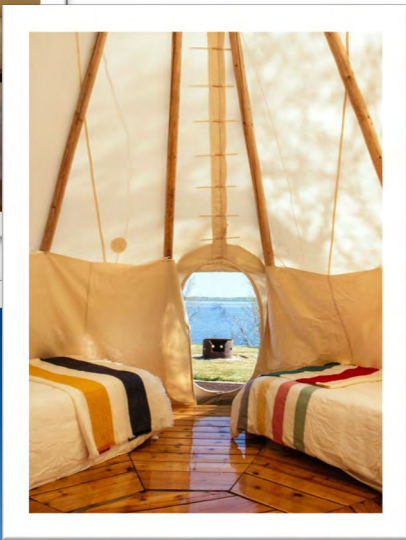
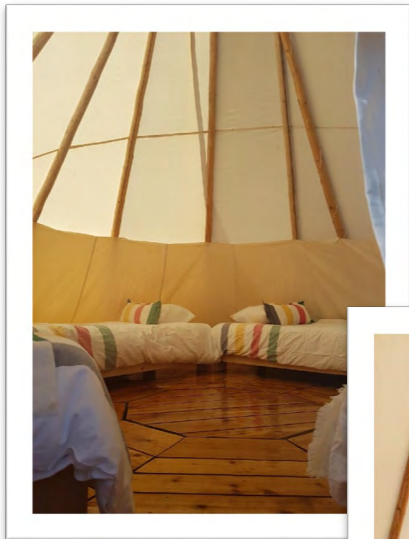
