Effective Date: July 28, 2019 until further notice

Where: Mt. Kidd RV Park Campground including campsites, trails and the permanent house trailer park.

Why: Black Bear frequenting the area.

Although a warning is in place for *this* area, bears can be encountered anywhere in Kananaskis Country and at any time. To avoid a surprise encounter with a bear:

- **Please make sure all attractants are properly stored. No food, garbage, recyclables, pet food or other scented items can be left outdoors at any time. Ensure garbage dumpsters are securely locked.**
- **Make plenty of noise and travel in groups.**
- **Be aware of your surroundings. Look and listen for bears and their signs.**
- **Keep your pet on a leash.**
- **Carry bear spray, make sure it's easily accessible, and know how to use it.**

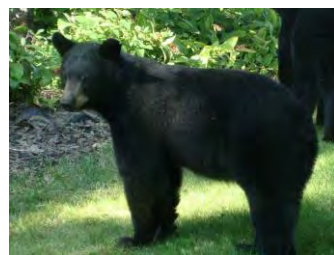
