# Winter Scavenger Hunt

### **Outdoor Activity**

Curriculum: Science, Literacy, Physical and Outdoor Education

Materials: Copy of attached scavenger hunt

### Instructions:

Download the <u>winter scavenger hunt</u> sheet.

- Go outside to explore your nearby nature or local park. How many scavenger hunt items can you find? Did you find your own discovery?
- Facilitate a sharing circle afterwards to celebrate student discoveries.

## Learning Extension – Poetry

Materials: journal, pen

#### Instructions:

- Write a short poem or story about one of the winter scavenger hunt or personal discoveries you experienced. The simplicity of a Haiku poem lends itself to winter.
  - Entire Haiku poem consists of three lines, with 17 syllables in total: first line is 5 syllables, second line is 7 syllables and third line is 5 syllables.
- Here are a few you can share with your students for inspiration.
