

William Watson Lodge: Reservation Guidelines



William Watson Lodge provides accessible overnight accommodation (cabins, campsites, and comfort camping) for persons with disabilities, seniors, and their friends & families. **To stay at William Watson Lodge (WWL) the primary occupant of the cabin or campsite must be an eligible guest.** Eligibility includes:

- **Albertans with disabilities** (physical, cognitive & sensory disabilities or medically fragile)
- **Out-of-Province persons with disabilities** (physical, cognitive & sensory disabilities or medically fragile)
- **Alberta Seniors** (65 years and over)

This eligibility ensures that those of greatest need are able to access William Watson Lodge. If your needs do not require supportive, accessible accommodation (e.g. lift assist, medical beds, accessible design) please use alternative accommodations.

Reservation guidelines:

- Eligible guests must be present upon check in and check out - if the eligible guest is not present, the reservation will be cancelled without refund
- One reservation can be made for one unit (e.g. campsite, cabin or comfort camping) by *or for* an eligible guest at one time
- An eligible guest may bring additional family, friends and caregivers up to the maximum unit capacity
 - e.g. if you are staying in a cabin that sleeps 8 people, your reservation may be up to a maximum of 8 people, all staying in the same cabin
- Albertans with disabilities can reserve 120 days in advance of their stay
- Out-of-province persons with disabilities can reserve 60 days in advance of their stay
- Alberta Seniors (65 years and over) can reserve 60 days in advance of their stay

Reserving a cabin:

- A minimum of 2 nights must be reserved. A maximum of 7 nights can be reserved per season:
 - Summer Season (June - September) guests may have 1 reservation for a maximum of 7 night stay
 - Winter Season (October - May) guests may have 2 reservations for a combined 7 night stay
- Check in anytime after 3:30pm, and before 9:00pm. Check out anytime before 11:00am.
- Check out requires cleaning & tidying of cabin, details provided at check in.

Reserving a campsite:

- The campground is open from May Long weekend to October Long weekend annually. Eligible guests may have up to 2 reservations for a maximum stay of 14 nights.
