

Changing a Backcountry Permit

Note: If you have printed your backcountry camping permit, you are not currently able to make any changes. Please contact the Alberta Parks Call Centre to process the required changes.

- 1. Sign into your <u>Shop.AlbertaPark.ca</u> account.
- 2. Select "Current Reservations" from the options on the left-hand side
- 3. Select the "See Detail" button of the reservation you would like to change.





- 4. Click the "Update Reservation" link on the Reservation Details page.
 - If the permit dates or location do not need to be changed, you can update group and emergency contact information here.

6. The ltinerary window may be minimized at the bottom of the browser window. Click on the tab to expand it.

7. Remove all or the portions of your current permit itinerary to you'd like to change.





- 8. Select you new dates and/or locations and select the "Add to ltinerary" button. Once your dates/locations have been confirmed, click the "Book" button on the My Itinerary tab.
 - If you want to change your camping stay to another backcountry park, first cancel the original permit and make a new reservation for the new backcountry park.



- 9. If required, update your group or emergency contact information and then select the "Confirm Changes" button at the bottom of the window. This will add your changes to the cart to process applicable fees. There is a \$10 fee for changes and if dates or people have been added/ removed, the payment required will be adjusted.
- 10. After payment has been processed, the changes can be confirmed/ viewed through the "Current Reservations" link.
