



Welcome to Kinbrook Island Provincial Park located on Lake Newell. Lake Newell is one of southern Alberta's largest and warmest man-made lakes. Enjoy canoeing, kayaking, sailing, fishing, swimming, motorized water sports and more. An interpretive trail takes you through the nearby wetlands and introduces you to the area's many bird species. Kinbrook Island Provincial Park is also close enough for a day trip to the Brooks Aqueduct (~15 minute drive) and Dinosaur Provincial Park, UNESCO World Heritage Site (~45 minute drive).

### Regulations

- Quiet hours in effect 11 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Please drive cautiously and obey all speed limits. Park roads are also used by pedestrians and cyclists.
- Prevent damage to trees and vegetation. By keeping your vehicles on designated roads and parking areas.
- Alcohol is only permitted in registered campsites. Alcohol is not permitted on roads, trails, beaches, washrooms, day use picnic areas and other public areas.
- For the safety of your pet, wildlife and visitors, keep your pet on a leash at all times (max length 6' or 2 m). Please pick up after your pet.
- Pets are not permitted on beaches, swimming areas or in public buildings.
- Campfires are only permitted only in designated fire pits and stoves. Never leave your campfire unattended and make sure it is completely out before leaving your campsite.
